What is Stewardship?

In biblical terms, Charles Bugg defines stewardship in the Holman Bible Dictionary as: "Utilizing and managing all resources God provides for the glory of God and the betterment of His creation." Christian Stewardship regards the obligation of Christians in managing and utilizing intelligently the gifts that God has given.

More often than not, when we think of good stewardship, we think of how we manage our finances and our faithfulness in paying God's tithes and offerings. But it's much more than that. In fact, it's more than just the management of our time, our possessions, our environment or our health. Stewardship is our obedient witness to God's sovereignty. It's what motivates the follower of Christ to move into action, doing deeds that manifest our belief in Him.

Stewardship defines our practical obedience in the administration of everything under our control, everything entrusted to us. It is the consecration of one's self and possessions to God's service. It acknowledges in practice that we do NOT have the right of control over ourselves or our property- God has that control. Faithful stewardship means that we fully acknowledge we are not our own but belong to Christ, the Lord, who gave Himself for us. Being a good steward in this world is one way of expressing our love for God and our gratitude to Him.

The ultimate question, then, is this: Am I the lord of my life, or is Christ the Lord of my life? In essence, stewardship expresses our total obedience to God and Jesus Christ. I&S Ministry Team

Update from Session on Transitional Pastor (formerly known as an interim)

We are very close to hiring a transitional pastor and expect to share more details soon. In addition to providing full-time pastor duties for Trinity, the transitional pastor will help us as follows:

In partnership with the Session, work toward a healthy and productive transition between called pastors by:

- Assisting the congregation to review its history and identify its gifts and passions
- Identifying and mentoring new and emerging leaders in the congregation
- Exploring new directions for ministry in the community
- Assisting the congregation to resolve conflicts and solve problems constructively
- Assessing the current staffing model
- Assessing the current committee structure, including Session and Deacons' Board
- Drafting the job description of the next installed pastor
- Evaluating the church's financial and material assets
- Strengthening the relationship of the congregation with the Presbytery and Synod
- Prepare the congregation for the arrival of the next installed pastor

The transitional pastor will not be involved in the search process of the Pastor Nominating Committee and will not be eligible to be a candidate for the pastoral office of our church.

Heal House residents use several things on a daily basis. The items either wear out or are used quickly. The shelter board has a wish list of items needed. Trinity's Mission Team wants to help provide some of the items on the wish list that the residents use frequently. During the month of November, Mission is asking the congregation to bring to the church atrium any of the following items: toilet paper, small Kleenex boxes, wash cloths, hand towels, liquid hand soap, liquid laundry soap, eco-friendly bio degradable paper plates, eco-friendly disposal coffee cups with lids. Let's follow God's word (*Hebrews 13:16*) "And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased."





In the spring of 2023, the WeLIFT Board of Directors and staff agreed there are many local barriers that impeded our client's ability to gain and sustain employment. The Compassion Fund was created for our working clients to help pay for items like; required clothing/footwear, transportation, small vehicle repairs and maintenance, critical documents like birth certificates and IDs, short term emergency housing and IMU/rent incentives for our financial workshops (participants are required to attend all

financial workshops - programs are usually between 5-7 weeks and upon completion each participant receives money toward their rent or utility bill).
